

## Piecework

### Numeric Response

1. Some jobs pay on a piecework basis. This is where the worker is paid for each item produced.

$$\text{Total\_Pay} = \text{Rate\_per\_Item} \times \text{Number\_Produced}$$

Alva Nunex is a punch press operator for Mighty Machine. She earns \$0.83 for every form she presses. What is her total pay for after she presses 1102 forms? Enter your answer as a dollar amount and round to the nearest cent.

On Saturdays you are paid an additional 28 cents for each carton you fill. What is your total pay for a week in which you filled the following number of cartons?

5. You are an upholsterer and work in the upholstery department of a furniture factory. You are paid at the following rates: \$127 for each couch, \$115 for each loveseat, and \$83 for each chair that you upholster. During the last 4 weeks, you upholstered 6 couches, 24 chairs and 27 loveseats. What is your total pay for the 4 weeks of work?
6. You are an upholsterer and work in the upholstery department of a furniture factory. You are paid at the following rates: \$140 for each couch, \$125 for each loveseat, and \$61 for each chair that you upholster. During the last 4 weeks, you upholstered 7 couches, 22 chairs and 29 loveseats. What is your total pay for the 4 weeks of work?
