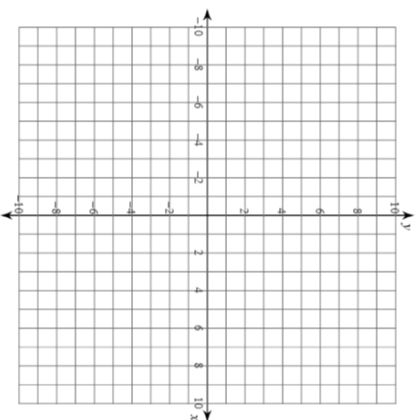

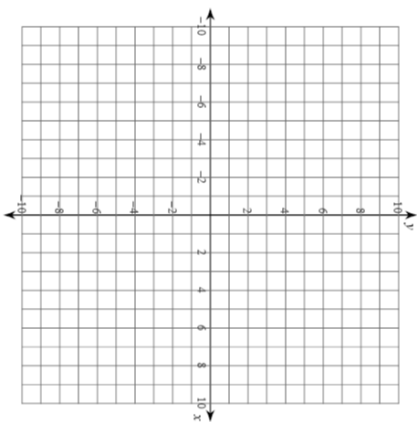
standard form of a linear equation:

point-slope form of a line:

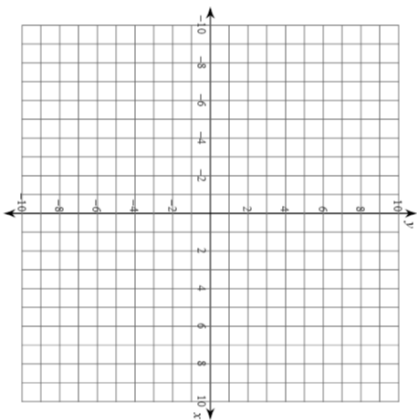
Graph: $y = \frac{7}{2}x - 5$



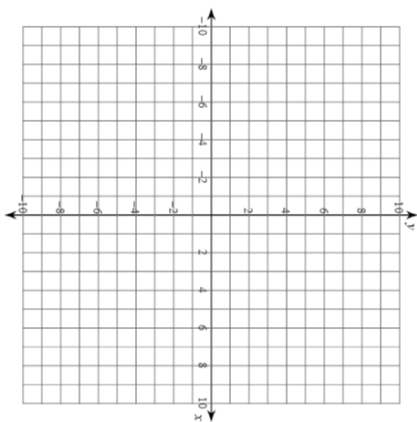
Graph:

y-intercept: 5



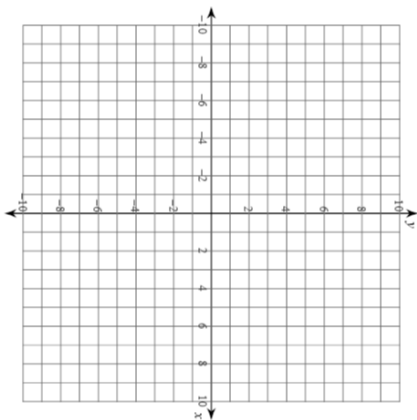
Graph:

y-intercept: -2



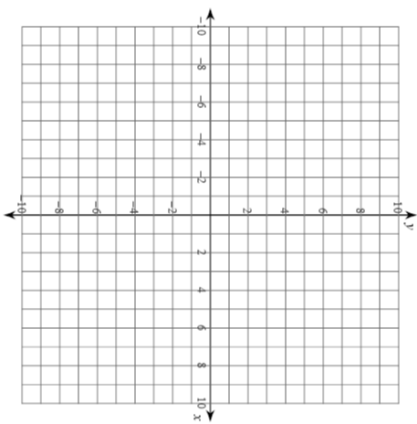
Graph: $y = -4$



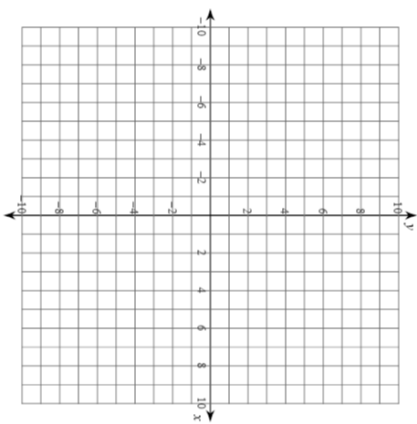
Graph: $x = -2$



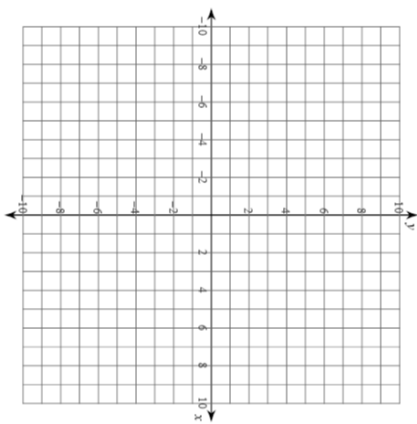
Graph: $6x + 4 - y = 0$
