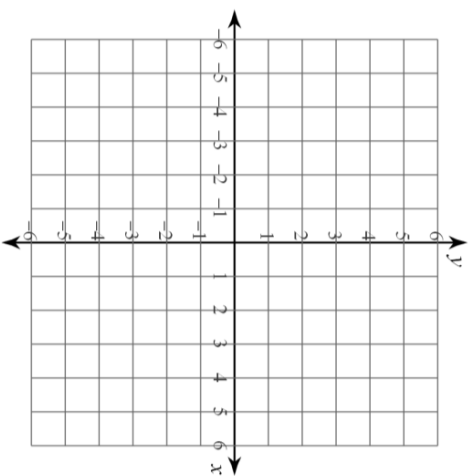


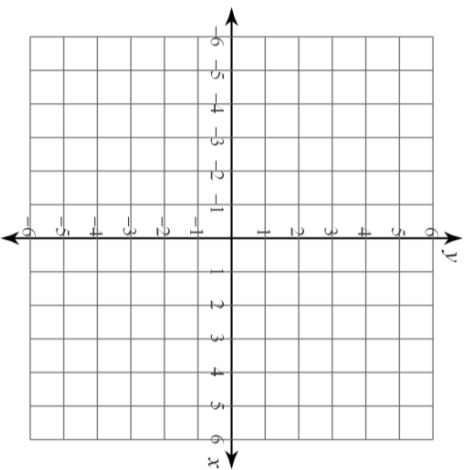
standard form of a linear equation:
 $Ax + By = C$ where A and B are not both zero.

example: $4x + 3y = 24$

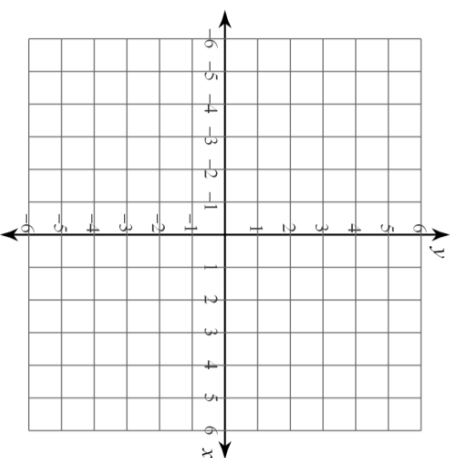
$$8x + 5y = -25$$



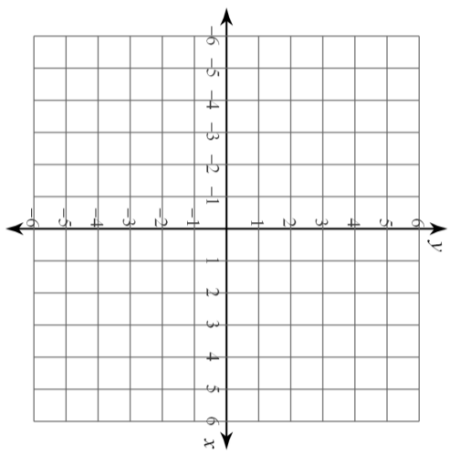
$$4x - 5y = -10$$



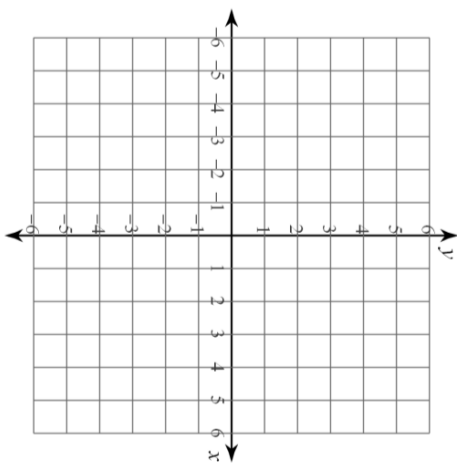
$$8x + 3y = 15$$



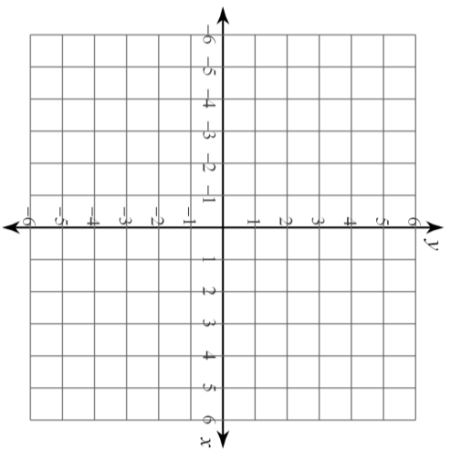
$$x + y = 2$$



$$2x - y = 5$$



$$x + y = -1$$



$$2x - 3y = 6$$
