4. C. Finley is a vice-president. This month his travel expenses include: airfare of \$2,142, taxi fares of \$76.54, meals of \$282.59, hotel stays of \$479, and miscellaneous of \$97.03. What is the total travel expense for C. Finley? Round your answer to the nearest cent.
5. L. Columbo is a vice-president. This month his travel expenses include: airfare of \$2,213, taxi fares of \$73.33, meals of \$309.38, hotel stays of \$549, and miscellaneous of \$94.69. What is the total travel expense for L. Columbo? Round your answer to the nearest cent.
6. M. Knight is a vice-president. This month his travel expenses include: airfare of \$2,524, taxi fares of \$78.59, meals of \$307.90, hotel stays of \$93 per night for four nights, and miscellaneous of \$71.12. What is the total travel expense for M. Knight? Round your answer to the nearest cent.
7. B. Duke is a receptionist. This month his travel expenses include: airfare of \$2,431, taxi fares of \$62.71, meals of \$314.57, hotel stays of \$101 per night for four nights, and miscellaneous of \$61.34. What is the total travel expense for B. Duke? Round your answer to the nearest cent.
8. M. Knight is an administrator. This month his travel expenses include: airfare of \$2,707, taxi fares of \$54.25, meals of \$277.66, hotel stays of \$104 per night for seven nights, and miscellaneous of \$57.72. What is the total travel expense for M. Knight? Round your answer to the nearest cent.
